

Graduate Diploma in Community Health Nursing

Duration of Course:

2 – 5 years (Part-Time)

The Graduate Diploma in Community Health Nursing is offered under a modular, stackable coursework structure. The programme consists of six modules with a total of 32 MCs comprising three core and three specialty modules with both theoretical and work-based learning.

Entry Requirement:

Applicants must:

- be a registered nurse with a valid practising certificate from Singapore Nursing Board;
- possess a Bachelor's Degree in Nursing from an accredited programme;
- obtain CAP ≥ 3.00 for each graduate certificate (NUR5801G, NUR5802G and NUR5806G); and
- have at least one year's working experience in the community health setting.

NUR5803G	Community Health Practice (4MC)
NUR5804G	Chronic Disease Management In the Community (4MC)

NUR5806G	Evidence-Based Practice (4MC)

The course commences in January 2019. There is one intake per academic year.
