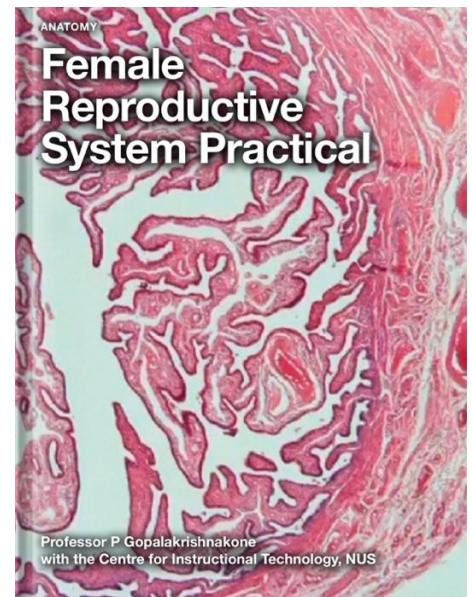


MOBILE LEARNING PROGRAMME

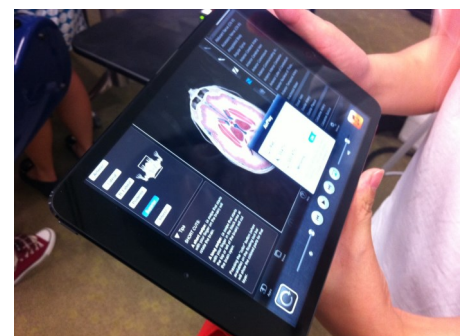
Through the integration of technology into today's learning, the Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine has recently embarked on a Mobile Learning Programme to explore how mobile computing platforms can be used to enhance teaching and learning in medical education.

The 2-year pilot programme aims to compile best practices of mobile learning which will subsequently be implemented across numerous cohorts and courses. Students in the AY2012/2013 Phase I (medical year 1) cohort who do not own a tablet are given a subsidy to buy an iPad, Android or other tablet that meets the programme's minimum specifications. Staff and students can also apply for funding to embark on their own mobile learning projects that will enhance their teaching or learning.
